Regular Meeting

3. Public comment. In accordance with the Texas Attorney General’s opinion, any public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will only be heard by the Board of Commissioners. No formal action, discussion, deliberation, nor comment will be made by the Board of Commissioners.
4. District Manager’s report and Chiefs/Director’s reports on monthly activities of the VFDs and PEMSI, and review reports/information submitted by the VFDs and PEMSI.
5. Review and approve minutes of the September 17, 2018 public hearing and regular meeting.
6. Treasurer’s report on District’s finances, and review and consider any proposed budget amendments.
7. Discuss and take action to approve and authorize payment of the District’s bills and accounts, along with PEMSI and the VFDs’ expenditure reimbursement requests.
8. Review, discuss, and take action on purchase and expenditure requests submitted by departments, including a rescue boat for Port Bolivar VFD.
9. Discuss status and take any needed action regarding transfer of EMS operations from PEMSI to the District.
10. Review, discuss and take action of proposed modifications to VFDs’ service agreements.
11. Discuss and take any needed action concerning procedure for and use of a consent agenda for future Board meetings.
