MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING AND REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF GALVESTON COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2

A public hearing and regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Galveston County Emergency Services District No. 2 ("District") was called for at 3:00 p.m. on September 14, 2021, at the Crystal Beach fire station, located at 930 Noble Carl Road, Crystal Beach, Texas 77650, pursuant to notice duly posted and published according to law.

At approximately 3:00 p.m., the public hearing was called to order. The roll was called of the duly constituted officers and members of the Board, to wit:

All of said Board members were present, thus constituting a quorum. Also present were Doug Saunders, District Manager; Georgia Osten, District Administrative Assistant; Joshua Heinz of Benckenstein & Oxford, LLP, attorneys for the District; and, the individuals listed on the attendance log attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

Upon establishing that a quorum was present, President Newberry directed the Board to public hearing Agenda Item No. 3, at which time the Board members and others in attendance said the U.S. and Texas pledges of allegiance.

The Board was then directed to public hearing Agenda Item No. 4, at which time Treasurer Strong reviewed and discussed with the Board and others in attendance the District's proposed 2021 property tax rate (\$0.076387/\$100), which will increase property taxes for the 2021 tax year. President Newberry then invited questions and comments from those in attendance regarding the District's proposed 2021 property tax rate, and there was no response.

Accordingly, the public hearing was adjourned at approximately 3:02 p.m., and the regular meeting was called to order immediately thereafter.

Since a quorum had already been established, President Newberry asked for public comment as set forth in regular meeting Agenda Item No. 3, and being as there was none, the Board moved along to regular meeting Agenda Item No. 4, at which time Treasurer Strong presented the Board with and reviewed the District's proposed fiscal year 2021-22 budget. Then, Robert Isaacks of High Island VFD addressed the Board concerning High Island VFD's 2021-22 budget as proposed, and he requested additional funds be allocated for the department equipment purchases and vehicle maintenance; and, in response, the Board advised that it will consider any additional funds needed for necessary expenditures in excess of budgeted amount if and when such arise. The Board also discussed with Mr. Isaacks the amounts of funds which High Island VFD currently has on hand and available. Treasurer Strong then made a motion to approve and adopt the District's fiscal year 2021-22 budget as proposed, which was seconded by Secretary Fountain and unanimously approved by the Board. The Resolution Adopting Budget, which includes the District's approved fiscal year 2021-22 budget as an attachment and the District's 2021 Tax Rate Calculation Worksheet as an addendum, is attached hereto as Exhibit B.

Next, the Board was directed to regular meeting Agenda Item No. 5 regarding the District's 2021 property tax rate, at which time Treasurer Strong made a motion that the District's property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a 2021 property tax rate of \$0.076387/\$100, which is effectively a 4.11% increase in taxes, and approve an order for levy of same. The motion was seconded by Secretary Fountain. A record vote was taken on the District's 2021 property tax rate, the results of which were as follows: For: President Newberry, Vice President Lee, Secretary Fountain, Treasurer Strong, and Assistant Treasurer Flanagan;

Against: None; Present and Not Voting: None; and, Absent and Not Voting: None. The Order Levying Taxes is attached hereto as **Exhibit C**. Mr. Heinz will forward a copy of the Order Levying Taxes to the Galveston County Tax Office, and he will post the required Notice of Adopted Tax Rate, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit D**, on the District's website.

The Board was then directed by President Newberry to regular meeting Agenda Item No. 6, at which time Assistant Treasurer Flanagan requested that consent agenda items (b) and (c) be pulled for separate discussion and consideration. Treasurer Strong then made a motion to approve and authorize the following other matters listed under the consent agenda, which was seconded by Assistant Treasurer Flanagan and unanimously approved by the Board:

a. Minutes of the August 18, 2021 Regular Meeting.

Concerning the matters listed under consent agenda item (c), Mr. Saunders advised that Board that it had been discovered that High Island VFD had previously requested and received from the District reimbursement for certain expenditures totaling \$2,899.07, and that the department had also claimed and reported to the Galveston County Firefighters Association that said expenditures had been paid with funds received from Galveston County. Accordingly, Mr. Saunders recommended that High Island VFD's reimbursement amount for its August 2021 expenditures be reduced by the aforementioned amount in order for the District to recoup the funds previously paid to the department based on its improper and invalid reimbursement request (\$19,781.48 - \$2,899.07 = \$16,882.41). Assistant Treasurer Flanagan also had questions regarding the cost of certain vehicle repairs performed by Mel's Mechanic Shop and submitted for reimbursement by Crystal Beach VFD.

Then, concerning the matters listed under consent agenda item (b), Assistant Treasurer Flanagan had questions about EMS invoices paid by credit card as opposed to being billed to the

District and paid by check upon Board approval, including, but not limited to, the vehicles repair invoice from Affordable Truck Repair. Mr. Saunders explained that payment was required at the time of completion of the repair services because the District did not have an account set up with that particular vendor. After discussing said matters in detail, Treasurer Strong made a motion to approve the following remaining consent agenda items, which was seconded by Secretary Fountain and approved by all of the Board members present:

- b. Payment of District Bills and Accounts (Exhibit E)1; and,
- c. VFDs' Monthly Expense Reimbursements $(\underline{Exhibit F})^2$.

The Board then moved along to regular meeting Agenda Item No. 7, at which time Treasurer Strong reviewed with the Board his regular Treasurer's Report and the District's monthly financial records³, copies of which are attached hereto as **Exhibit G**. Treasurer Strong also advised the Board on the amount of the most recent sales tax revenue payment received, which was well in excess of the amount received during same period of the previous year. Treasurer Strong then reviewed with the Board the proposed 2020-21 Budget Amendment Nos. ESD-03⁴ and EMS-01⁵, copies of which are attached hereto as **Exhibit H**. Upon motion by Treasurer Strong and seconded by Secretary Fountain, Budget Amendment Nos. ESD-03 and EMS-01 were unanimously approved.

Then, under regular meeting Agenda Item No. 8, at which time Mr. Saunders reviewed the BuyBoard purchasing cooperative price sheet, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit I**, for a proposed new EMS supervisor vehicle (2022 Ford F-150 crew cab or equivalent based on price and availability), which Mr. Saunders recommends the District purchase. Upon motion by Vice President Lee and seconded by Secretary Fountain, the Board approved and authorized the purchase of a new EMS supervisor vehicle at an amount not to exceed \$47,000.00. Mr. Saunders also advised that the new ambulance previously ordered by the District is about ready, and he requested approval of the revised purchase amount, which increased slightly due to certain modifications/additions. Upon motion by Treasurer Strong and seconded by Secretary Fountain, the Board unanimously approved the revised purchase price for the new ambulance in an amount not to exceed \$170,000.00.

The Board was then directed to regular meeting Agenda Item No. 9, at which time Mr. Saunders and Mr. Heinz reviewed with the Board the proposed Paid Quarantine Leave Policy for the District, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit J**, and they advised on the recent legislation requiring such policy. After discussing the matter, Secretary Fountain made a motion to approve and adopt the Paid Quarantine Leave Policy as proposed. The motion was seconded by Treasurer Strong and unanimously approved by the Board.

After tabling regular meeting Agenda Item No. 10, the Board moved along to regular meeting Agenda Item No. 11, at which time Mr. Saunders provided the Board with further details on the matter concerning High Island VFD's received of funds from the District for expenditures which it also claimed and reported to have paid for with funds received by the department from Galveston County, which the District has now recouped from High Island VFD

Cleaning Supplies (42340) by \$2,000.00, Good of Department (42740) by \$1,000.00, Vehicle Maintenance (44900) by \$25,000.00, and Fuel (44200) by \$7,000.00.

by reducing its August 2021 expense reimbursement by said amount. The Board discussed trust issues it now has with High Island VFD and the oversight and management of the department's financial affairs. The Board members agreed that absent a change in High Island VFD's membership and changes to the manner in which its financial affairs are managed and monitored. Upon motion by Assistant Treasurer Flanagan and seconded by Secretary Fountain, the Board members unanimously authorized Mr. Saunders to submit a letter to High Island VFD advising of the Board's concerns and requests and the potential actions by the Board should such issues not be remedied.

The Board was then directed to regular meeting Agenda Item No. 12, at which time Mr. Saunders reviewed with the members his written Manager's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit K**.

Thereafter, President Newberry directed the Board to regular meeting Agenda Item No. 13, at which time the Board reviewed the various financial reports prepared by David Sticker, copies of which are attached hereto as **Exhibit L**.

The Board then moved along to regular meeting Agenda Item No. 14, at which time Mr. Heinz advised that he will be posting all of the required records and required notices relating to the District's 2021 property tax rate, along with the Truth-in-Taxation records and information required under Sec. 26.18 of the Texas Tax Code, on the District's website.

Lastly, under regular meeting Agenda Item No. 15, the Board discussed and announced that its next regular meeting will be held on October 13, 2021 at 3:00 p.m.

Being as there were no other matters to come before the Board the regular meeting was adjourned at approximately 5:52 p.m.

WHEREAS, the appraisal roll of Galveston County Emergency Services District No. 2 (the "District") for 2021 has been prepared and certified by the appraiser for the District and submitted to the District and its tax assessor/collector; and

WHEREAS, the Galveston County Tax Assessor/Collector, being the District's tax assessor/collector, has prepared and submitted to the District its 2021 tax rate calculation worksheet; and

WHEREAS, based on the certified appraisal roll for the District, dated July 24, 2021, and the tax rate calculation worksheet for the District, certified and dated July 29, 2021, which were submitted to the Board of Emergency Services Commissioners of the District by the Galveston Central Appraisal District and the Galveston County Tax Assessor/Collector, respectively, the total taxable value of property is \$1,598,126,447; and

WHEREAS, based upon the certified appraisal roll and the tax rate calculation worksheet, the employee or officer designated by the Board of Emergency Services Commissioners of the District has calculated a tax rate to be levied for 2021 sufficient to provide tax revenues to meet the District's obligations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF EMERGENCY SERVICE COMMISSIONERS OF GALVESTON COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2 THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> The District has previously adopted a budget for the upcoming fiscal year, which will be funded, in part, from the revenues generated by the tax rate established in this order levying taxes.

Section 2. There is levied an ad valorem tax of \$0.076387 on each \$100.00 of taxable property within the District in order to provide funds for maintenance and operating purposes.

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 4.11 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$0.00.

Section 3. All taxes collected pursuant to this levy, after paying costs of levying, assessing and collecting the taxes, will be used for paying costs of providing emergency services and organization and administrative expenses, and for paying principal of and interest on bonds, warrants, certificates of obligation or other lawfully authorized evidences of indebtedness issued or assumed by the unit.

Section 4. The Galveston County Tax Assessor/Collector is authorized to assess and collect the taxes of the District employing the above tax rate.

Section 5. The taxes levied by this Order are due presently, and will be delinquent if not paid by January 31, 2022.

Section 6. This Order Levying Taxes is effective from and after its adoption.

PAID QUARANTINE LEAVE POLICY

Statement of Purpose/Applicability

Pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 180.008, Galveston County Emergency Services District No. 2 ("GCESD No. 2" or the "District") hereby adopts this paid quarantine leave policy for the emergency medical technicians who are employed by the District and ordered to quarantine or isolate due to a possible or known exposure to a communicable disease while on duty.

See Texas Local Govt. Code § 180.008(b).

Definitions

"Emergency medical technician" means an individual who is employed by GCESD No. 2 and certified as an emergency medical technician under Chapter 773, Health and Safety Code.

"Paid quarantine leave" means: (1) all employment benefits and compensation, including leave accrual, pension benefits, and health benefit plan benefits provided by the District; and (2) if applicable, reimbursement for reasonable costs related to the quarantine, including lodging, medical, and transportation costs.

See Texas Local Govt. Code § 180.008(a).

Quarantine Leave

A GCESD No. 2 emergency medical technician who is ordered to quarantine or isolate by the person's supervisor or the District's medical director due to a possible or known exposure to a communicable disease while on duty is entitled to receive paid quarantine leave for the duration of the leave.

See Texas Local Govt. Code § 180.008(c).

No Reduction in Compensation and Benefits

GCESD No. 2 will not reduce an emergency medical technician's paid time off (PTO) or other paid leave balance in connection with paid quarantine leave taken in accordance with this policy.

See Texas Local Govt. Code § 180.008(d).

Policy Effective Date

This paid quarantine leave policy is effective as of June 15, 2021.

Highlights of August 31, 2021 Financial statements:

Cash in banks and TexStar total \$2,008,643 as of August 31, 2021.

Revenue for the 11 months of Oct 1, 2020 to August 31, 2021 is \$2,549,960. With one month remaining in the fiscal year the budgeted revenue will be met and exceeded.

Expenses total \$2,109,822 compared to annual budgeted expenses of 2,688,077.

I have substantially completed the review of three VFDs. Comments on each VFD are below. The period of review was October 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021. Reviewed items were insurance coverage, review of bank accounts, review of roster of members of each fire department along with training, along with items from prior reviews that required corrective action.

Crystal Beach VFD –No major issues were noted. There are some minor yet important changes that I will recommend after some additional study. One example is there is a requirement for 2 signatures on each check, however this restriction is not stated on the face of the check. I would rather the face of the check indicate 2 signatures required with 2 lines on the check. I need to do a little more research on this.

Total cash on hand in bank as of June 30, 2021 - \$227,918.

High Island VFD – Issue noted and not resolved is a payment made to a vendor and the claim for reimbursement was made to both the Galveston County 22,500 grant and to the Galveston ESD. At this time the error is noted and was discussed with the VFD. We went over procedures necessary to prevent this from occurring in the future. I will visit again with the ESD and the VFD and determine the resolution to this matter. The High Island VFD has a policy requiring 2 signatures for checks above \$750 and 1 signature for up to \$750. The policy that is in place needs some updating and I will visit with the VFD and make and discuss recommendations.

Total Cash on hand in bank as of June 30, 2021 - \$92,719

Port Bolivar VFD -

No major issues were noted however there are improvements that can be made on cash disbursements that are similar to the improvements noted in the other 2 VFDs in regards to signatures and approval of disbursements.

Total cash on hand in bank as of June 30, 2021 - \$199,495.

On the next review I will concentrate on both cash disbursements and cash receipts - procedures for protecting funds received related to fund raising and donations. In addition I will review the IRS tax filing for the entity.
