Special Meeting

1. Call to order.
2. Determination of quorum.
3. Review, discuss and take action to accept and approve the District’s 2022 Certified Appraisal Roll prepared and provided by the Galveston Central Appraisal District and the District’s 2022 Tax Rate Calculation Worksheet prepared and provided by the Galveston County Tax Assessor/Collector, and authorize publication of posting of same on the District’s website.
4. Review and discuss the District’s fiscal year 2022-23 budget, and take action to approve the District’s *proposed* 2022-23 budget by record vote.
5. Discuss and take action to approve the District’s *proposed* 2022 property tax rate by record vote, and, if necessary, schedule and announce a public hearing concerning proposed tax rate increase and meeting at which Board will vote to adopt the District’s 2022 property tax rate, as well as the publication/posting of required notices in the newspaper and on the District’s website.
6. Such other matters that may come before the board.
7. Adjourn.
