MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF GALVESTON COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2

A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Galveston County Emergency Services District No. 2 ("District") was called for at 12:00 p.m. on August 16, 2023, at the Crystal Beach fire station, located at 930 Noble Carl Road, Crystal Beach, Texas 77650, pursuant to notice duly posted and published according to law.

At approximately 12:00 p.m., the regular meeting was called to order. The roll was called of the duly constituted officers and members of the Board, to wit:

All of said Board members were present, with the exception of Assistant Treasurer Flanagan, thus constituting a quorum. Also present were Doug Saunders, District Manager; Frank DeMarco, EMS Operations Supervisor; Georgia Osten, District Administrative Assistant; Joshua Heinz of Benckenstein & Oxford, LLP, attorneys for the District; MaKayla Vidal, accountant for the District; and, the individuals listed on the attendance log attached hereto as

Exhibit A.

Upon establishing that a quorum was present, President Newberry directed the Board to Agenda Item No. 3, at which time the Board members and others in attendance said the U.S. and Texas pledges of allegiance.

President Newberry then asked for public comment as set forth in the Agenda Item No. 4, at which time Malcolm Comeaux requested that the ESD Board request that the Galveston Co. Commissioners Court implement a firework ban due to the ongoing drought.

The Board then moved to Agenda Item No. 5, at which time Mr. Heinz reported on the 2023 tax rate notices and other tax/budget-related records being posted and published, and he reviewed with the Board the upcoming schedule for adopting the District's fiscal year 2023-24 budget and setting the District's 2023 property tax rate. He also confirmed with the Board and others in attendance that the public hearing concerning the 2023 tax rate will be held on Wednesday, September 20, 2023 beginning at 12:00 p.m., with the regular meeting immediately following at which the Board will take action to adopt the District's fiscal year 2023-24 budget and set the 2023 tax rate.

Next, the Board's attention was directed to Agenda Item No. 6, at which time Treasurer Strong made a motion to approve and authorize the following matters listed under the consent agenda, which was seconded by Secretary Fountain and unanimously approved by the Board members present:

- a. Minutes of the July 19, 2023 Regular Meeting and the August 9, 2023 Special Meeting;
- b. Payment of District Bills and Accounts (Exhibit B)1; and,
- c. VFDs' Monthly Expense Reimbursements $(\underline{Exhibit C})^2$.

The Board was then directed to Agenda Item No. 7, at which time Treasurer Strong reviewed the regular Treasurer's Report, which is attached hereto as **Exhibit D**³. Mr. Saunders then reviewed and discussed with the Board the following proposed 2022-23 budget amendments: ESD-003, EMS-001, and PBVFD-002, copies of which are attached hereto as

Exhibit E. Upon motion by Treasurer Strong and seconded by Secretary Fountain, the Board unanimously approved the ESD-003 budget amendment. Upon motion by Treasurer Strong and seconded by Vice President Lee, the Board unanimously approved the EMS-001 budget amendment. Upon motion by Treasurer Strong and seconded by Secretary Fountain, the Board unanimously approved the PBVFD-002 budget amendment. The Board also reviewed and discussed the proposed HIVFD-002 budget amendment but determined that such needed to be corrected and resubmitted by High Island VFD.

The Board then moved along to Agenda Item No. 8, at which time Mr. Saunders reported on and reviewed with the Board the proposals received for the EMS Unit 21 ambulance remount. Mr. Saunders sent the previously approved request for proposal to six (6) reputable vendors, and received back three (3) proposals. A summary of the ambulance remount proposals received is attached hereto as **Exhibit F**. Mr. Saunders recommended Emergency Transport Associates out of Rock Hill, South Carolina to perform the EMS Unit 21 ambulance remount, as said vendor submitted the lowest bid price (\$125,558.35, including \$5,000 trade allowance for current ambulance chassis), and it is able to complete the project by early November. Upon motion by Secretary Fountain and seconded by Treasurer Strong, the Board unanimously accepted and approved the ambulance remount proposal submitted by Emergency Transport Associates., and authorized Mr. Saunders to move forward in accordance therewith.

President Newberry then directed the Board's attention to Agenda Item No. 9, at which time Mr. Saunders reviewed and discussed with the Board the District's current EMS/ambulance fee schedule, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit G**, and advised that in accordance with a recently enacted law, said rates must be reviewed and approved by the Board and reported to the Texas Department of Insurance on an annual basis. Upon motion by Treasurer Strong and

seconded by Secretary Fountain, the Board unanimously approved the District's current EMS/ambulance fee schedule.

Thereafter, the Board moved along to Agenda Item No. 10, at which time Frank Demarco reviewed with the Board his monthly EMS Operations Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit H**.

The Board was then directed to Agenda Item No 11, at which time Mr. Saunders reviewed with the Board his monthly Manager's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit I**.

Next, being as there was no further report from counsel under Agenda Item No. 12, the Board was directed to Agenda Item No. 13, at which time Mrs. Vidal reviewed the various District financial reports with the Board, copies of which are attached hereto as **Exhibit J**.

Being as there were no other matters to come before the Board under Agenda Item No. 14, the regular meeting was adjourned at approximately 12:57 p.m.

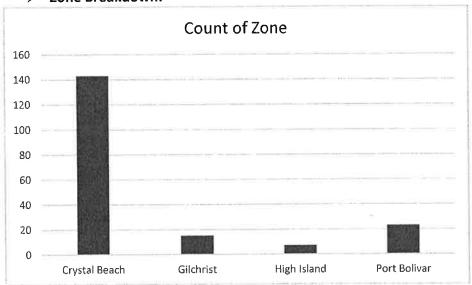

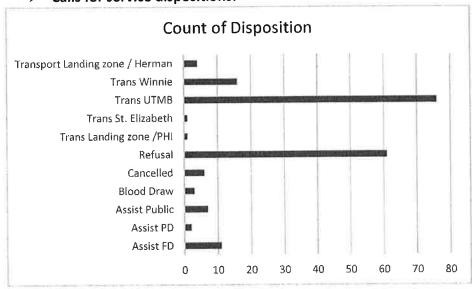

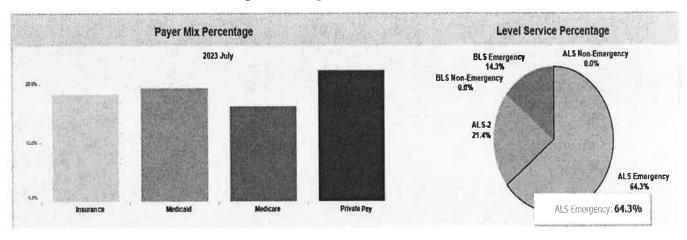
